The program is designed in collaboration with the Department of Monumental and Decorative art and Design named after V.G. Smagin related to INRTU School of Architecture, Construction and Design.

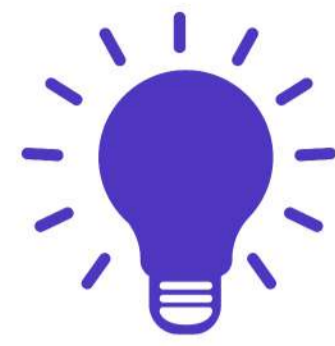
Our dedicated staff will be available around the clock throughout the program to ensure your well-being.

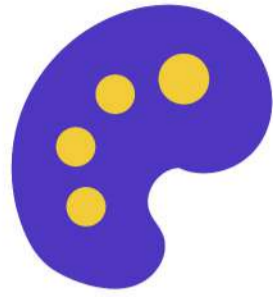

The total fee is 160 000 russian rubles.

This charge includes:

- transportation from / to the airport
- tuition fee during 3 weeks
- art supplies and drawing media: pens, pencils, sketchbooks, brushes, paints, pastels, paper, special materials for working with mosaics and ceramics tiles, etc.
- dormitory accommodation in Irkutsk
- transportation: Irkutsk - Olkhon Island - Irkutsk
- accomodation on Olkhon Island
- 3-course meal on Olkhon Island
- tickets for sightseeing and excursions in Irkutsk and on Olkhon Island

Each participant at his/her own expense pays for:

- visa
- cost of travel to/ from Irkutsk
- meals in Irkutsk
- medical insurance
- personal expenses
