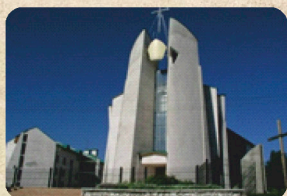


**1. INRTU (university buildings)**

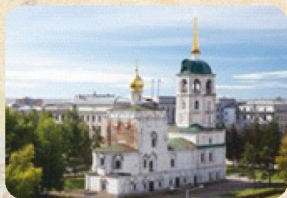

## BUS TOUR. *Historical City Center (2 hours)*



**The Savior's Church.** *It is the first church built by Cossacks in 1672 and the oldest stone structure in the entire Irkutsk Region. This church is extremely unique as there are no other churches in Siberia that have frescoes on their outer walls.*

**The Victory Square.** *The place to commemorate all Russians including 200 000 Irkutsk people who fought in the cruel and merciless war with the German fascists.*

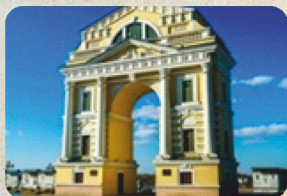
**The Statue of Y. Pokhabov.** *The statue is devoted to Cossacks who were explorers of Siberia and founders of Irkutsk.*

10 – 15-minute walk from the Victory Square



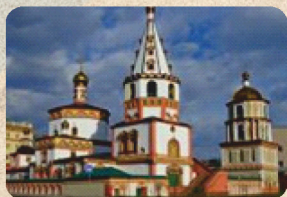
**The Statue to the first teacher.** *A bronze statue was founded in 2016 opposite the building of the Pedagogical University. It represents the importance of the first teacher in the life of children, wisdom and love for children.*

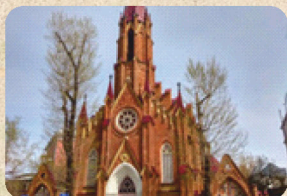
**The Moscow Triumphant Gates.** *Reconstructed gates which were built in 1813 in an Empire style. That time in the long past they led people to the Moscow highway*

**The Epiphany Church.** *It is the second oldest church of our city founded in 1719. It stands out in its outer decoration containing new Baroque elements in combination with Asian motives.*

**Polish Roman Catholic Church of Lady of the Assumption.** *It was founded in 1881-1884 by Polish exiles. Since 1978 it functions as an Organ Hall.*

**Count Speransky Square(Kirov's Square)**

*The square was situated near historical center on the shores of the Angara as a market place. In 1886 it got the name of Count Speransky to honor Irkutsk General Governor Mikhail Speransky. The square had different names during various periods of time. It got its original historical name in 2016.*

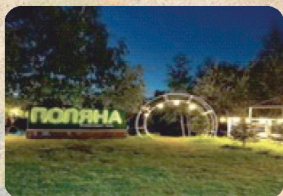

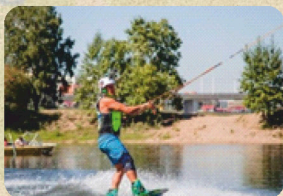

### **Island "Konny".**

*"Konny" Island is a popular place among Irkutsk residents. It is located on the Angara next to "Yunost" Island, near the Children's Eastern Railway. There is the tallest Ferris wheel in the city on the island. In summer you can ride on catamarans there, and in winter the island has ice tracks for skating. Various public events, festivals, and fairs take place there. You can feed the ducks or just sit on the beautiful river bank.*

**The Ferris wheel "Outlook".** Established on the 30th of June in 2018 it gives joy of admiring splendid views of the city at a height of 50 meters.

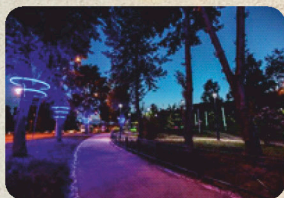

**The monument to Alexander the III.** In 2003 an obelisk and monument to the Tsar appeared as a sign of deep gratitude from the residents of Siberia. Aleksander the third was the person who ordered to construct the Great Siberian Railway

**The Okhlopkov's Drama Theatre.** *Being wooden initially the building burnt in fire three times and in 1897 on money of local merchants a new stone building was erected. It impresses with its perfect acoustics, beautiful interior, majestic atmosphere.*

(The 130th quarter) (2 hours)**



**The Statue of Babr.** *The statue depicts a babr with a sable in its teeth. These animals are present at the coat of arms of which was granted to the city in 1690. The babr is believed to be a peculiar kind of a tiger that lived in the wilderness near Baikal that disappeared 300 years ago.*

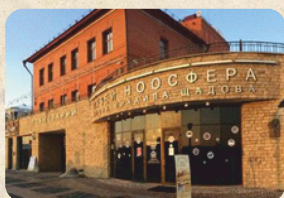


**The Charoite room.** *This is the place where you get acquainted with the charoite, a rare mineral. It is extracted only in Russia, only on the border of Yakutia and the Irkutsk region, in the valley of the Chara river.*

**The Planetarium, observatory and museum “Noosphere”.**

*Sitting in an armchair and looking upwards you will see films about the space. The screen is fantastic here! It has a form of a dome of 9 meters wide over you.*

**Trading and entertaining center “Fashion district”.** *Except shopping, eating tasty food at cosy cafes you can enjoy a beautiful and big fountain inside the building. In a warm period it works but in winter it serves as a place for huge, unusual and impressive compositions.*

**The Irkutsk Musical Theater after Zagurskiy.** *The building of the Irkutsk Musical Theater after Zagurskiy was founded in October 1940. Along with traditional vaudevilles the theater stages operas and ballets.*

**Edison Craft Bar.** *The bar is popular among those people who like live jazz or rock music. The owners are musicians. And they assure that they have the equipment which provides one of the best sounds in the entire Irkutsk.*
