A number of lectures will be devoted to Lake Baikal, its origin, ecosystems and climate. The Russian language course will include 36 academic hours. The total number of contact hours is 72, classes are held on weekdays for 4-6 academic hours per day. The School will be represented by expert teachers from Irkutsk, Russian and foreign universities.

Academic classes are accompanied by the diverse extracurricular activities. The School participants are invited to take part in guided tours, to visit museums, theatres, churches, galleries, planetarium and other well-known and interesting places of Irkutsk. The highlight of the cultural program is a 4-day trip to Lake Baikal.

International Summer School

Expenses

The total fee is 80 000 rubles. This charge includes:

- tuition costs,
- transportation from and to the airport,
- accommodation and meals (breakfast&lunch) during the period of the Summer School in Irkutsk and accommodation and breakfast on Olkhon Island,
- cultural program (transportation and excursions in Irkutsk city, Listvyanka and Olkhon Island).

Each participant at his/her own cost and expense pays for:

- the cost of travel to and from Irkutsk:
- medical insurance,
- visa fee (attendees have to apply for humanitarian (scientific and technical links) or study visa (depends on your home country),
- dinners (≈ 500 rubles per 1 meal),
- personal expenses,
- additional workshops (≈ 1500 2000 rubles).
