Postgraduate studies in the field of training 06/39/01 Sociological sciences. Social structure, social institutions and processes opened in 1994.

Graduates of postgraduate studies work in various universities and organizations in Russia, USA, China, Japan, Vietnam.

Over the years of its existence, more than 10 candidates of sociological and philosophical sciences have been trained.

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROGRAM

The postgraduate program is aimed at analyzing social changes in societies in a state of limiting / transitional processes.

When conducting empirical research, graduate students are supported by the staff of the Center for Complex Sociological Research, who have a high level of qualifications and practical skills in conducting practical sociological work.

Terms of study:
3 years full-time education,
4 years part-time education.

The program involves the conduct of lectures and practical classes in the direction of postgraduate studies, as well as the creation of a research group by a graduate student of students and masters of various training areas to practice the skills of group research, project management, and leadership development.



DESCRIPTION OF THE PROGRAM

The program is suitable for all persons with higher education, confirmed by a specialist or master's diploma, regardless of the basic specialty received.

The postgraduate training program is being implemented in the tradition of the established scientific sociological school of IRNITU, the main tasks of which are:

The formation of skills in research and teaching activities;

Development of leadership qualities, teamwork skills, through mentoring;

Development of skills in the use of qualitative and quantitative methods of sociological research;

The use of various resources of INRTU (the presence of students in various areas of training) when conducting research;

A friendly atmosphere in the research team and the opportunity to receive qualified psychological advice from psychologists.

Research work is usually combined with teaching or working as an analyst, sociologist, project manager in specialized research centers, research institutes of academies of sciences or in research centers and laboratories at leading universities.

In addition, graduates of sociological faculties can work in their specialty in large industries as specialists in sociological services or as specialists in personnel management. A very popular area of practical application of sociology is sociological expertise.
