University of Wrocław is one of the oldest universities in Central and Eastern Europe with a rich, more than three hundred-year-old history and traditions. During the 20th century the University had given the world 9 Nobel laureates in physics, literature, chemistry and medicine. More than 1200 international students from 100 countries study at the university. The University of Wrocław is the only Polish university that belongs to the ISEP global exchange network with 250 universities-participants from all over the world, including 132 American ones. This is the third university in Poland where the foreign students have the most choice.
