



## 1. Initial Application PLEASE send the application documents to admission@istu.edu

- application form (can be downloaded from the website www.istu.edu/apply);
- copy of international passport (passport must be valid for at least 18 months from the date of visa issue).
- copy of certificate of secondary education or diploma with supplement(s) and notarized translation into Russian or English.

If your application is successful and you receive preliminary acceptance, the University starts the invitation process.

2. Examination stage

#### Applicants take 2 exams:

- English language (or provide TOEFL 550 points, TOEFL iBT – 87 points, IELTS
   6.0 or equivalent);
- Mathematics.

3. Receiving the acceptance letter and submitting documents to the UNIVERSITY

Applicants receive the acceptance letter with the list of the documents to submit and instructions about all the further necessary steps to enter the university
