Table (3) for Countries Where Higher Education Credentials Specify an Average Grade (hereinafter, GPA)

Country / Degree Classification System	Required Average Grade or Degree Classification
Ghana, Nigeria, and other English-speaking African countries	A higher education degree classified as First Class, with academic achievement of 70% or higher
Cameroon and other French-speaking African countries	A higher education degree awarded with an “Excellent/Très Bien” classification, with academic achievement of 80% or higher
Russia, Uzbekistan, Kyrgyzstan, and Tajikistan	A higher education degree with a GPA of 4.75 or higher
China	A higher education degree with an average grade of 95 or higher
Bangladesh	A higher education degree with a GPA of 4.0
Other countries	Individual assessment by an INRTU specialist responsible for evaluating foreign educational credentials to determine whether the applicable threshold is met
